Minutes of the Remote Meeting of the Parish Council held on 3rd March 2021 at 7.00pm via video conference

3/21/177 To receive apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Doughty.

3/21/178 To receive any new declarations of interest or dispensation requests

Cllr Skelton declared a non pecuniary interest in the planning application 21/00269/HSE as a neighbour.

3/21/179 Public Forum

A Cllr had been approached by a resident regarding vehicles using Broomfield Lane. It is understood that a response had been sent via Nottinghamshire County Council.

3/21/180 To receive reports from District & County Councillors

Cty Cllr Taylor gave a report on the following:

- Covid 19 – The Local Resilience Forum is continuing, offering help and advice to residents. The vaccination system was going very well and now moving to vaccinate over 60s. There had been a good uptake throughout the County. Those eligible for free school meals will continue to receive them during the Easter holidays via the County Council.
- The County Council budget had been set with a 2.9% rise and 1% adult social care increase. There were no plans to cut front line services.
- The Daneshill Environmental Impact Assessment had not yet been submitted to NCC by the site owners so there had been no further progress on the planning application.

- 3/21/185 Update on traffic issues**
There had been no further information received from Everton Parish Council regarding traffic monitoring.
Some complaints had been received by a Parish Councillor regarding the condition of Mattersey speed bumps. These had suffered damage but had partially been repaired. A discussion took place as to the effectiveness and desirability of the speed bumps. Resolved: to conduct an online survey of residents as to whether they would like to see them removed.

It was agreed that Mattersey Millennium Green be added to the list of dog exclusion areas.

The cost for each property had been assessed by BT OpenReach and amounted to £1500 per property. This meant that it was just outside the value for the Notts CC Scheme. However further enquiries were being made as to whether the Scheme could be progressed.

- An email had been received complaining about the lack of action regarding flooding caused by the lack of work on River Idle. The River Idle Management Partnership had made little progress. Cllrs suggested further enquiries be made with the Environment Agency regarding the calibration of the pumping station at Mattersey. It was also felt that this lack of action could result in a further problem with mosquitos in warm weather.
